

Step By Step

1. Dry emboss Whisper White (4" x 5-1/4") using the Softly Falling embossing folder. Secure to your Real Red card base.
2. Die cut zig zag from the Nothing Sweeter Bundle down the left side of your Crumb Cake card stock.
3. Punch one strip of Real Red using your border punch. Trim 5 scallops off and tuck it behind your Crumb Cake rectangle as shown. Secure to your card base.
4. Punch out a starburst using your Starburst Punch and your Whisper White square.
5. Stamp Christmas Greetings from the Nothing Sweeter stamp set In Pool Party in the lower right hand section of your starburst.
6. Stamp your Santa and the North Pole Sign in Tuxedo Black ink onto your Whisper White rectangle (2-1/4" x 4-1/2"). Stamp "North Pole" in Real Red ink onto your sign.
7. Color in your Santa and North Pole sign using your Real Red and Pool Party Stampin' Blends.
8. Die cut your Santa and your North Pole Sign.
9. Attach your North Pole sign with regular adhesive and your Santa with Dimensionals.
